



Marshals Guide

This document is a formal guide and final instruction will always be given at events by the Chief Marshal.

All Marshals

- ◆ **MUST** be at least 16 years old.
- ◆ **MUST** attend the Chief Marshals briefing BEFORE going on to the course
- ◆ **MUST** identify themselves and sign on (ACU/insurance purposes) - and in most occasions collect a ticket for a FREE burger and drink.
- ◆ **MUST** always wear a High Visibility vest (supplied by Tbec).
- ◆ Replace or report damaged course markings.
- ◆ Assist any fallen rider and protect him/her from other competitors.
- ◆ Stay with an injured rider and send another marshal or a competitor for help (in the case of a suspected serious injury the competitor should not be moved or his helmet removed - wait for the paramedic).
- ◆ Report any competitor who does anything to endanger other riders (e.g. riding against the direction of the course, attempting to overtake when there is insufficient room, etc.)
- ◆ Report any rider who intentionally cuts the course.

Report all events to the Chief Marshal or Clerk of the Course.

Static Marshals

- ◆ Must remain at their allocated point on the course until relieved.

Travelling Marshals

- ◆ **MUST** be a TBEC member
- ◆ **MUST** remove or cover up any race numbers on their bikes.
- ◆ **MUST** not race and ALWAYS give way to competitors at all times.
- ◆ TM's may come off the course at any time or stop on the course at a safe point to observe; however they should avoid riding in groups and should circulate in order to identify any problems as quickly as possible.
